What data does he need?

Data to collect

- Demographics
- Weight every week
- Compliance with diet ?

How could he collect it?

Hint: he has a website

- Get people to email him
- Comments on a blog
- Entries in a forum
- Specially design software

How is he collecting it?

Data is collected using forum software. Each dieter has their own thread and each week updates an inline table with new data. They then post a new message to that thread to flag that it has been updated.

Some problems

- Biggest problem: self-reported
 - Might drop out if not going well
 - Might lie!
- No consistent format (easy to make transcription errors)
- How could you resolve these problems?
